What is Adoration?

Whether this is your first time or hundredth time in adoration, you are welcome to come join us as we delve into prayer before Jesus in the Eucharist.

As Catholics, we believe Jesus' own words that He is truly present in the Bread of Life. Adoration is simply spending time in prayer, reading, reflecting, and giving thanks to God...in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. All are welcome to come, take a seat or kneel, and spend time in silent personal prayer.

What you do in adoration is up to you – it is a beautiful, personal prayer time in the silence of the chapel, in the presence of Jesus. Most people participate in silent prayer, pay the Rosary, read the Bible, or read another book that helps them connect with Jesus in a fuller and deeper way. There is no “right” way to do a Holy Hour. Come and experience adoration and time with the Lord.

The Most Holy Trinity Adoration Chapel at Our Lady of Grace is open to all Monday through Friday from 5:00 AM to 11:00 PM all year long. Come join us in this peaceful space to pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament.
