New Business

2021 New Member Introductions

New Council members beginning their three-year term in 2021 are Caron Trierweiler, Bill Egan, and Drew Pearson. Caron was present at the meeting and introduced herself to the Council. New members were selected based on various factors including their involvement in parish ministries and continuing representation of the parish demographics of the members that are rolling off of the Council in June.

Social Justice and Pastoral Care Ministry: Our Lady of Grace Race, Equity and Healing Initiative

Prior to this meeting, the Council was provided with a ministry update summarizing April 15, 2021, and May 5, 2021, meetings to review approaches to address racial equity/diversity by the OLG Catholic Community. During the meeting Mary Absolon presented a new initiative that she has been involved in with other members of the OLG community, including Regina Neville, and the larger Edina community. Regina provided additional information about the work that has been done to date. Mary Absolon recommended the Council approve two motions:

- 1. Commission the Our Lady of Grace ("OLG") Race, Equity and Healing Initiative to develop and implement approaches to advance OLG's Mission of Making Jesus Christ Known and Loved through Racial Equity and Healing.
- 2. Recommend Regina Neville as Chair for the OLG Race, Equity and Healing Initiative.

Steve Schreiber seconded the motion, and the recommendations were approved.

PPC Member Reflections

Prior to the meeting, Council members reflected on a Rose, a Thorn, and a Bud with a Rose being a highlight, success, win, positive impact; a Thorn being a challenge they experience or need more support with and a Bud being a new idea for 2021-2022. Members shared one item with the group. The members' Rose, Bud and Thorn comments will be aggregated and considered in guiding the 2021-2022 Council year.

Joint PPC / School Advisory Council ("SAC") Joint Meeting

The Joint PPC / SAC portion of the meeting kicked off with member introductions, discussion of the June 5th and 6th graduation and Return to Mass, Return to Community weekend, and a recap of the Advancing Our Mission Campaign.
