
Julie Moran Elementary School Principal

## FINANCIAL REPORT

Dear Friends,

The financial results for Our Lady of Grace for fiscal years ended June 30, 2022, and 2021 as well as the budget for fiscal year 2023 are on the following pages. Over the past year, despite continuing economic uncertainty, OLG's community has continued to support our beautiful parish in so many ways. Our families are filling our pews once again, and Mass attendance is growing. Our school and ministries are growing, and our Mission of "Making Jesus Christ Known and Loved" is being felt across the entire metro area, the country, and the world. We were blessed to finish the construction of our new Activity Center which will be the home of our new Preschool as well as our faith formation ministries and growing Pre-K through 8 school. In addition, for the first time in our rich 75-year history, Our Lady of Grace now has a beautiful gymnasium and performing arts center that will serve our parish and school families for generations to come. Finally, we celebrated our Dedication Weekend by inviting our parishioners and the local community to tour our campus, and the overwhelming response was one of gratitude and pride.

From a financial results standpoint, we ended fiscal year 2022 with a net "Ordinary Income" surplus against the budget and previous fiscal year results. The Ordinary Income results reflect how we manage our day-to-day operations. At a summary level, the revenues collected from all ministries were 13.8% better than our projected budget. We experienced a 14.9% increase in "collection revenue" over the budget and 13.0% increase over the previous year's collections. It is this collection revenue that funds many of our ministries and pays for the day-to-day operating expenses of the parish. We are blessed by your generosity.

In addition to a surplus in the day-to-day, "Ordinary" financial performance of the parish and school, we experienced a net loss after "Other" income and expenses were calculated, and this shortfall was expected. "Other" income and expense includes gains and losses on our parish investment accounts held at Catholic Community Foundation (see Endowment page for additional details), any special gifts we received over the course of the fiscal year, and the costs associated with the "Advancing Our Mission" (AOM) building campaign. In previous years we reported a surplus in our "Other" Income and Expense accounts as we collected campaign pledges prior to spending the funds for the construction of the new buildings. In fiscal year 2022, we built our new building and paid just under \$14 million towards this project.

We continue to spend considerable time and energy growing our three endowments (Parish, School, and Cassidy). The endowments are very important to the long-term financial future of our parish and school. We were blessed to receive financial gifts that went directly into the endowment funds at Catholic Community Foundation (CCF). However, as many know, the investment market(s) experienced weak performance results throughout the fiscal year, and our endowments experienced losses reflecting the overall financial market's performance for the fiscal year.

In closing, we remain committed to operating the finances of our parish in a balanced way to maintain your trust. We ask you to recommit yourselves to this beautiful faith community as well. Please prayerfully consider making a new financial commitment or increasing your financial commitment to allow us to continue to build a bright, Christ-filled future for Our Lady of Grace and for all those we serve. Please help us continue to live our parish mission: "To Make Jesus Christ Known and Loved." We depend on your committed financial support.


### Stewardship Prayer

Our endowment funds are professionally invested and protected from any liabilities of the parish, the Archdiocese, and all other Catholic entities.
