PHASE 1: Our parish in order



Campus Enhancements/Maintenance

Replace, repair, enhance facilities needing attention across the campus.



Priest Residence

Construction of on-campus housing for five priests to live in community including those who may be retired or visiting so that they may have a place of rest.

PHASE 2: Meeting our current needs while building a foundation for our future



Activity Center A new multi-purpose space featuring a full-size gym with divisible partitions, performing arts stage, auxiliary space for music equipment, locker rooms and a reception area.



Preschool

A new preschool at the front of the Activity Center for up to 120 children ages 33 months to 5 years old.



Restroom Improvements

Renovation and expansion of the main church bathrooms into the current nursery space. Nursery will be relocated.



Kitchen

Cafeteria

A new professional grade kitchen capable to accommodate school lunches and parish programs such as funeral luncheons, Sharing & Caring Hands, etc.



Traffic and Parking Additional parking or Additional parking and improvements to handicapped, seniors and Adoration Chapel spaces, preschool drop-off/pickup and school carpool/bus traffic. Enhanced safety with landscaped boulevards.




Connecting the church to the new Activity Center, includes classrooms, new Frassati (youth) Room, multi-use atrium and innovative learning spaces.









